

#### CITY ORDINANCE NO. 18-2020

A CITY ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF MALOLOS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-THREE PESOS AND FORTY-FIVE CENTAVOS (PHP136,823,443.45) TO BE USED AS AUGMENTATION IN ITS EFFORT IN COMBATING TO CONTAINING AND FIGHTING COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. 7160 mandates the implementation of projects and programs by the Local Government Units (LGUs) that will redound to the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor thru the Office of the City Planning and Development Office, respectfully requested the City Council to adopt, authorize and approve the City of Malolos Development Council Resolution No. 04-2020, which was approved on April 13, 2020 by the Local Development Council during its general meeting;

WHEREAS, the law provides that any amendments to the Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), Local Development Investment Program (LDIP) and Annual Investment Program (AIP), the Local Development Council shall approve thru a Board Resolution any changes or updates to the aforementioned;

WHEREAS, Art. 182 of Rule XXIII mandates every Local Government Units (LGUs) to have a comprehensive multi-sectoral development plan to be initiated by the Local Development Council (LDC) and approved by the concerned Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, the City of Malolos Development Council (CMDC) approved the Annual Investment Program (AIP) and the allocation of the 20% development fund for the year 2017, 2018 and 2019 thru the CMDC Resolution Nos. 05-2016, 01-2017 and 03-2018 respectively;

WHEREAS, Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) - Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01 dated 27 March, 2020 provides additional guidelines on the utilization of the twenty percent (20%) of the annual internal revenue allotment for development projects in view of the Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) situation;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the passage of a Supplemental Budget for the efficient implementation of COVID-19 related response;

WHEREAS, Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Local Budget Circular No. 125 dated April 7, 2020 provides guidelines on the release and utilization of the Bayanihan Grant to Cities and Municipalities in the amount of P64,764,795.00;

WHEREAS, there is a neeed to realign the PPAs funded under the 20% development fund for fiscal year 2017, 2018 and 2019 to be used as additional fund for COVID-19 related PPAs to address this Pandemic.

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Committee certifies the existence of saving and the availability of funds to realize the Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) as mentioned in CMDC Resolution No. 04-2020;

WHEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. this city Ordinance shall be known and cited as the 'COVID-19 Pandemic Response Fund".

SECTION 2. - The amount of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-THREE PESOS AND FORTY-FIVE CENTAVOS (PHP136,823,443.45) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of the City to meet the programmed expenses in the Supplemental Budget No. 1 as follows:

SECTION 3. - The provision of this City Ordinance shall be used solely on the stated purpose in addressing the COVID-19 pandemic. Any savings or unutilized funds under this Ordinance shall be automatically reverted to the general fund and or 20% Development Fund subject to the general guidelines under DBM, DILG, COA regulation and Circular.

SECTION 4. - RELIEF OPERATION - It is hereby mandated that the P60M allocation stated under Section 2 of this Ordinance intended to augment relief operation of the City shall be distributed to all barangays based on their total households, which shall receive atleast 20 kilos of rice per household, as follows:
