**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 42-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CITY LABORATORY TESTING CENTER, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**WHEREAS**, Section 15 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.

**WHEREAS**, Section 11 of Article XIII of the same Constitution further declared that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers.

**WHEREAS**, it is the primary duty of the City Government of Malolos to protect the well-being of its constituents;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7610 also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government units (LGU's) shall implement programs and project for the general welfare and development of its constituents;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Malolos in session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. - Title** - This Ordinance shall be known and be cited as the "CITY LABORATORY TESTING CENTER"

**SECTION 2. - CITY LABORATORY TESTING CENTER** - This City Ordinance mandates the establishment of a City Laboratory Testing Center to cater primarily those residents of the City of Malolos who are considered indigent as listed in the listahanan of the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) and those individual who needs laboratory test as properly advised/prescribed by a licensed physician or medical doctor.

This City Laboratory Testing Center shall be under the supervision of the City Mayor through the City Health Office and be temporarily housed in the Health Center located at Maunlad Homes, Mojon, City of Malolos.

SECTION 3. - SERVICES TO BE OFFERED - The City Laboratory Testing Center shall provide the following as its minimum laboratory testing services:

- 1. ECG - An electrocardiogram (ECG) is a test which measures the electrical activity of a heart to show whether or not it is working normally. An ECG records the heart's rhythm and activity on a moving strip of paper or a line on a screen.
2. X-RAY - is a quick, painless test that produces images of the structures inside a body - particularly the bones. X-ray beams pass through the body, and they are absorbed in different amounts depending on the density of the material they pass through.
3. URINALYSIS - is a test of urine. A urinalysis is used to detect and manage a wide range of disorders, such as urinary tract infections, kidney disease and diabetes.
4. CBC - Complete Blood Count (CBC) is a blood test used to evaluate one's overall health and detect a wide range of disorders, including anemia, infection and leukemia.
5. Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) - is a laboratory test used to check stool samples for hidden (occult) blood.
6. Blood Typing - is a test that determines a person's blood type.
7. ULTRASOUND - is a medical test that uses high-frequency sound waves to capture live images from the inside of a body.

FUTURE EXPANSION/SERVICES - If the financial capability of the City will permit and can accommodate, the following laboratory tests shall be included in its basic services:

- 1. Diagnostic Tests / 2D Echo - Two-Dimensional Echocardiography can provide excellent images of the heart, paracardiac structures, and the great vessels.
2. MRI - Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) is a type of scan that uses strong magnetic fields and radio waves to produce detailed images of the inside of the body.
3. Dialysis - is a procedure to remove waste products and excess fluid from the blood when the kidneys stop working properly.

SECTION 4. - SERVICE FEE/CHARGE - The City Government shall adopt a Socialized Charging/Fee Scheme in its Fee Matrix for the services offered by the City Laboratory Testing Center.

Indigent residents, students (Elementary to Secondary), Persons with Disability, Senior Citizens, Veterans, Solo Parents who resides in the City of Malolos shall be free of charge.

SECTION 5. - FUNDING - The City Government of Malolos shall allocate the following funding support to its Annual General Appropriation Ordinance, to wit:

- A. For the first year of implementation, an initial funding to defray the expenses necessary for or incidental to the implementation of this Ordinance in the amount of FIVE MILLION PESOS (P5,000,000.00) shall be sourced from the fund of the City Government to carry out its duties and functions.
B. Every year thereafter, at least ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00) Pesos shall automatically be included in the Annual Budget of the City.

SECTION 6. - SHARING OF PROCEEDS FROM THE ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES - The amount of the corresponding penalty paid by a violator to the Barangay Treasurer shall be apportioned where the equivalent of twenty percent (20%) shall accrue to the enforcer as incentive. The remainder of the proceeds from penalties collected as payment by violators, after deducting the amounts that shall accrue to the enforcers shall form part of the general fund of the Barangay.

SECTION 7. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions thereof shall remain valid and effective.






SECTION 9. - EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon approval and upon compliance with Section 59 (c) of RA 7160.


