CITY ORDINANCE NO. 85-2020

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CITY FISHERMAN AND FARMER'S TRAINING CENTER, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, the City of Malolos is considered as a Rice-Producing City in the Province of Bulacan as well as in the whole of Region III (Central Luzon) wherein large portion of its vast area is dedicated as an agricultural land fit for farming;

WHEREAS, around 36 hectares of the City is dedicated for fishery/fishing and this serves as the source of livelihood of those living in its coastal barangays;

WHEREAS, the City is committed in assisting the National Government to achieve a 100% Rice Sufficiency by the end of 2022;

WHEREAS, one of the priorities of the City Government of Malolos is the development of its agriculture and aquaculture industry by providing new methodologies, techniques and devises to double the production output of farmers and fisherman and lowering the cost of production;

WHEREAS, it is inevitable to integrate new technologies available to the market to achieve this goal and by introducing modernization and mechanization in the agriculture sector in the city;

WHEREAS, farmers and fisherman needs to undergo preparation through seminars, workshops and rigid trainings to cope with the modern trends in the farming industry; WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7610 also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government units (LGU's) shall implement programs and project for the general welfare and development of its constituents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Malolos in Session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. - TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known and be cited as the "FISHERMAN AND FARMER'S TRAINING CENTER ORDINANCE".

SECTION 2. - DECLARATION OF POLICY - The City recognizes the vital role of the agriculture sector in its local economy which provides food security to its constituents and livelihood to farmers and fisher folks. It is the primary policy of the city to protect and develop the agriculture sector in the city by providing adequate training to farmers and fisher folks and the provisions of new and modern equipments (Modernization and Mechanization) and extending support to the sector.

SECTION 3. - ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CITY FISHERMAN AND FARMER'S TRAINING CENTER - In coordination with the Department of Education and TESDA, the City Agriculture's Office and the City Training, Employment and Cooperative office (CTECO) shall establish a City Fisherman and Farmer's Training Center (FFTC), a non-profit training center, in the City of Malolos.

It is highly suggested that the Center be established in Malolos Marine Fisheries and Laboratory High School (MMF&LHS).

The Center shall:

- a. Train the farmers and Fisherman in the City of Malolos and introduce new methodologies, techniques and equipment to help them in achieving high production output- low production cost;
- b. Conduct research and assessment of the present situation of the farming and fishing industry in the City;
- c. Coordinate with the Department of Agriculture (DAR) for the transfer of technology, Bureau of Fishery for program coordination and to other National Agency for technical Support;
- d. Coordinate with the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI) for new hybrid of rice;
- e. Recommend to the Local Chief Executive, the variety of rice that fit to the kind of soil present in the city;
- f. Help the Fisher folks to invigorate the production of fish in the coastal waters of the City;
- g. Coordinate with the National Food Authority (NFA) for the post harvest marketing;
- h. Facilitate research for post-harvest;

SECTION 4. - CREATION OF THE CITY FISHERMAN AND FARMER'S TRAINING CENTER BOARD - There is hereby created a City Fisherman and farmer's Center Board to be composed of the following:

- City Agriculture Office as the Chairman
- City Training, Employment and Cooperative as Vice Chairman
- City Planning and Development Office as Secretariat
- Representative from DepEd
- Representative from TESDA
- Representative from Fisherman's Organization
- Representative from Farmer's Organization
- 3 Representative from the NGO

SECTION 5. - FUNCTIONS OF THE CFFTCB - The Board shall act as the recommendatory body to the City Mayor for policy and program implementation and shall:

- 1. Formulate policy for the effective and efficient implementation of this ordinance;
- 2. Recommend to the LCE the hiring of qualified trainers;
- 3. Recommend for the procurement of the necessary tools, equipments and facilities such as but not limited to instructional materials, tractor, construction of building for the center among other;
- 4. Recommend for the conduct of "Educational Trip/Bench marking" with the learners/trainees;
- 5. Coordinate with the National Agency for program and project implementation and funding support;
- 6. Issue a certificate of completion to beneficiaries; and
- 7. Other functions necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. - PROVISION OF MODERN EQUIPMENTS - The City shall facilitate the procurement and distribution of modern equipments to farmers either as dole out or in the form of soft loans.

Coordinate with the Department of Agriculture for technology transfer and the provisions of new and modern equipments.

SECTION 7. FUNDING - The City Government of Malolos shall allocate at least FIVE MILLION PESOS (Php. 5,000,000.00) for the initial implementation of this ordinance and at least 2,000,000.00 thereafter in its Annual Appropriation Ordinance.

SECTION 8. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision or part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions thereof shall remain valid and effective.




SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon approval and upon compliance with Section 59 (c) of RA 7160.
