



## All about Malolos

Malolos is home to 252 thousand people and sits on the center or “the heart” of the Bulacan Province. It is bounded on the North by the municipalities of Calumpit and Plaridel, Guiguinto on the East, Paombong on the West and Bulacan and Manila Bay on the Southeast and South respectively making it a coastal city. The city covers 67.25 sq. km. of land, about 30 percent of which is a vast fishpond area with 5 barangay settlements mostly parallel along water ways. Cruising around the coastal barangays can be done within a day at a cost of about Php 1,200. Apart from boating, you can also visit the Barasoain Church (barasngsuwail) and its museum, which requires time to reminisce the past in a video being presented during tourists’ hour. The Poblacion area or Kamestisuhan presents old houses with architectural bearings, vestiges and renowned sights. Also, in the Kamistisuhan, the remnant of the old school signifies the 21 young women of Malolos given due recognition by Dr. Jose Rizal. Most awaited event for Maloleños is the Sto. Niño festival, celebrated every last Sunday of January highlighting the procession of different images of Jesus as a child.



Aside from the Barasoain Church, another religious structure worth visiting is the Malolos Church, now known as Cathedral Basilica Minore Immaculada Concepcion, the Presidencia Residencia which is being restored to its state

back to the time of the first Philippine Republic. Take the growth centers on a spin with almost a kilometer span by riding the famous karatig – owner type jeepneys traveling within or nearby (karatig) the links of the two major government entities in the city; the Provincial Government of Bulacan or the capitol and the City Government of Malolos or the city hall, for only Php 8. First Bulacan Industrial City (FBIC) is the industrial estate in the city with more than twenty (20) locators. Guinhawa, one of the growth centers, houses a residential subdivision, Bulacan State University, commercial shops, hospitals and government offices. A commercial area along Longos - Mac Arthur Highway is Cabanas with cinemas, banks, retail outlets, restaurants and a three storey building suited for business process outsourcing ventures. Lastly, the stage plays being presented by the Barasoain Kalinangan Foundation, Inc. exhibits the cultural inclination of Maloleños.
