CITY ORDINANCE NO. 16-2024

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE SUBMISSION OF MONTHLY REPORT OF CHILD BIRTHS IN ALL HOSPITALS, CLINICS, LYING-IN CLINICS TO THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE, PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 15 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the state shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.

Section 11 of Article XIII of the same Constitution further declared that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers.

It is the primary duty of the City Government of Malolos to protect the best interest of its constituents.

Republic Act No. 11148 or the an act scaling up the National and Local Health and Nutrition programs through a strengthened integrated strategy for maternal, neonatal, child health and nutrition in the first 1,000 days of life mandates the implementation of programs and projects that focused on the well-being of a new born and their mother.

The state declares its determination to eliminate hunger and reduce all forms of malnutrition. The state further maintains that ensuring healthy lives, promoting well-being, ending hunger and food insecurity, and achieving good nutrition for all ages are essential to the attainment of sustainable development.

The state commits to the Philippine Development Plan and the National Plans on nutrition to contribute to the improvement of the quality of human resources in the country, and the reduction of maternal and child stunting.

The state scales up nutrition intervention programs in the first 1000 days pf a child's life, and allocates resources in a sustainable manner to improve the nutritional status and to address the malnutrition of infants and young children from zero (0) to two (2) years olds, adolescent females, pregnant and lactating women, as well as to ensure growth and development of infants and young children.

Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the Local Government of 1991 provides that every local government units (LGU's) shall implement programs and project for the general welfare and development of its constituents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Malolos in session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. - TITLE** - This Ordinance shall be known and be cited as the "CHILD BIRTH REPORTING ORDINANCE".

**SECTION 2. - SCOPE** - The provision of this city ordinance shall be implemented within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Malolos. All hospitals, clinics and lying-in clinics whether public or private are covered by this ordinance.

**SECTION 3. - REPORTORIAL DUTY** - To properly record and monitor the child births in the City of Malolos, it is hereby mandated the submission of monthly reports of all hospitals, clinics and lying-in clinics to the City Health Office or to the nearest Rural Health Units (RHUs).

The monthly report shall contain the following details:

1. Live Births
  - a. Low birth Weight
  - b. Normal Birth Weight
2. Skilled Birth Attendant
3. Number of Deliveries
4. Type of Deliveries
  - a. NSD
  - b. CS
5. Pregnancy Outcome
  - a. Full Term
  - b. Preterm
  - c. Fetal Death
  - d. Abortion or miscarriage

**SECTION 4. - COLLATION** - The City Health Office shall collate all the submitted reports and shall maintain data bank and shall report the same to the Local Health Board (LHB) every quarter.

The City shall ensure the data privacy of the information taken from the hospitals.

**SECTION 5. - PENALTY** - Any hospital, clinics and lying-in clinics who shall fail to submit the required report shall be penalized as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	Php3,000.00
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	Php4,000.00
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	Php5,000.00 and/or revocation of business permit

**SECTION 6. - IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS** - The City Legal Office in coordination with the City Health Office shall formulate the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) for the effective implementation of this City Ordinance within 30 days from effectivity of this ordinance.

**SECTION 7. - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain valid and enforceable.

**SECTION 8. - REPEALING CLAUSE** - All ordinances, executive orders, administrative orders or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. - EFFECTIVITY** - The ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication.


